Hawai'i Neurotrauma Registry

The Hawai'i Neurotrauma Registry is a *voluntary* record for Hawai'i residents of any age who have had:

- Brain Injury
- Stroke
- Spinal Cord Injury



Holu lehua means "resilient" lehua. People with neurotrauma injuries are resilient like the lehua.

Why have a Neurotrauma Registry?

We want to understand the needs of Hawai'i residents of all ages who have had a stroke, traumatic brain injury or concussion, and/or spinal cord injury once they leave the hospital or care facility. This information will help us know what services are most required post-discharge.

The Neurotrauma Registry Project offers:

- The chance to provide valuable information that will help identify needed community supports and services, educate service providers, and develop safety and prevention plans and policies.
- Personalized information and referrals for persons with neurotrauma injuries.
